



SERVICE AND TECHNICIAN'S ASSESSMENT REPORT (STAR) PROGRAM

BHA's Service and Technician's Assessment Report (STAR) Program identifies contractors that strive to provide the best product and service for their clients. Using direct comments from member clients along with a scoring system in the categories of: Quality of Work, Responsiveness, Punctuality and Professionalism, BHA members collect input and submit feedback through the online web form.

Each review must score high enough to be included in the total and be dated within the calendar year. Based on the size of your company, you can qualify as a STAR award company for the year with 10 - 20 four star or higher submissions. All companies that meet the criteria will earn a Star Award Certificate and will be listed on the BHA website. For those qualifying companies that register at least 1 month prior to the BHA Spring event, a trophy will be presented to you, recognizing the outstanding service you provided to your region.

There were 27 STAR Awards given out last year. Congratulations to all of the winners!
